Texas A&M volleyball ready to face off against Texas State

The No. 14 Texas A&M women's volleyball team had a solid start to the season last weekend by winning two out of three matches in the McDonald's/Texas A&M Invitational Tournament. Tonight, the Aggies will attempt to add to that start as they host Texas State at 7 p.m. at G. Rollie White Coliseum.

The Aggies easily knocked off Georgia Southern and McNeese State 3-0 in both matches Friday. In the tournament final, the Aggies put up a good fight in falling to No. 3 UCLA 31-29, 30-27

to the challenge.




