Capitalizing on its beer reputation, it offers specials like "Beer Flight" and "Pint Night." "Sports and Pint Night are what brings people here," said waitress Kristin. Beyond the good service, she said she is impressed by how well the tavern is prepared for big events. "During big games, some bars I've worked at take an hour to get food to you, but here they really prepare for crowds."

Whether crowds come here for televised sports or for the semi-private booths downstairs, the cigarette smoke permeates everything. One regular said he "always wears his dirty laundry, since it will be masked with the smoke anyway."

Fox and Hound is open from 11 a.m. to 2 a.m. every day.

**Atmosphere:** While the busy surroundings were fitting for the tavern, the music seemed to irritate one customer who complained about the dated music playlist. (Not that anything is wrong with Will Smith's 1999 hit "Wild, Wild West.")

**What Not to Wear:** There is a dress code, but it seems to be the "no shirt, no shoes, no socks" variety. Everything from sleeveless shirts to party gear is passable.

**Crowd:** Still building at 11 p.m., the congregation is a typical mixture including graduate students, professors and locals.

**Collateral Damage:** \$\$\$\$ of \$\$\$\$\$. There is a price tag to the "upscale neighborhood" atmosphere, as food and drinks are a little more expensive than normal. Newer menu items like pizza and pizzas are improvements to the typical tired bar food.

**Crowd Appeal:** Thursday's "Pint Night" brings the most people to Fox and Hound. An awesome draft selection is a mere \$2 per pint. In hand, most people move on to billiards, shuffleboard, Golden Tee or trivia.

**Regulars Say:** "Beer Flight" was the real Adam Mikeal came out to the Fox and Hound. "When I want variety, I come here - particularly for my favorite beer, Belhaven," said the graduate student. With Beer Flight, he could sample pints of pre-selected beers at a lower price.

**If Fox and Hound was a party,** it would be pre-packaged and sold in a vending machine.

### New Vietnam TV show tackles gay issues

HO CHI MINH CITY, Vietnam - Vietnam's favorite TV show, "The Crime Police," opens its new season this month by tackling a taboo topic and offering a lesson about tolerance. The plot is groundbreaking for this communist country where sex is mentioned only in whispers, homosexuality is still largely considered a disease, and the state tightly con-

controls publishing and broadcasting. The 10-episode story line is adapted from an award-winning novel titled "Mot The Gioi Khong Co Dan Ba," or "A World Without Women," which took Vietnam by surprise in 2000 when it became the first book to address gay issues in a serious manner.

### Jeopardy! whiz ends win streak

LOS ANGELES - Has Ken Jennings ended his "Jeopardy!" streak? A report posted Wednesday

on TV Week's Web site said software engineer lost in a staped Tuesday, walking away with his 75th straight game worth about \$2.5 million overall cash and prizes.

A spokesperson for the show told TV Week that it would not close whether Jennings lost.

Jennings, 30, of Salt Lake City began his record-breaking June 2, with a six-week hiatus over summer reruns.
