a pair of snake-headed parents dancing to late Rick James' "Superfreak," to a desperate plea from a baby substitute melon, the film contains amazing visuals that, when combined with a great mix of pop hits, will be sure to resonate with an MTV generation. The use of different film speeds, unusual angles and a neck-speed jump cut editing all work together to craft a fast-paced experience that will leave audiences smiling.

The actors are all easily likeable, but unfortunately, their characters never evolve beyond an inoffensive cliché. There's the tough bass player, the perpetually high wild and crazy drummer, the mentally disturbed suicidal groupie lead guitarist, and a stumbling, stumbling mess of a manager.

Despite the characters' predictability, the chemistry and charisma of the cast make it hard to do anything but enjoy watching the band and verbally stab each other while struggling to move beyond the emotional drama of stolen lovers and infidelity. (Plus, it's a fun to watch a film featuring a cast with Australian accents).

The DVD features a slapped-together ensemble of extras that won't offer too much insight to the casual fan. There is a running commentary by Proyas, a collection of deleted scenes that offer no question as to why they were a "backstage pass" that is basically a well-intentioned piece of promotional fluff, a collection of interviews from the cast and crew that offer real insight beyond the usual self-congratulatory applause one finds on DVD interviews, a never-ending montage of outtakes featuring a collection of minor goofs that cause the audience to crack up.

It's fitting that a movie about a would-be rock band would have all the depth and profundity of a music video. "Garage Days" is a pretty film to look at, featuring a kaleidoscope of visual effects and unusual editing techniques, but the plot lacks the substance it needs to elevate itself beyond the cute flick it becomes. It may be a shallow film with more emphasis on visuals than story, but it is for that exact reason it becomes highly entertaining and thus, like most music videos, highly re-watchable.

Freddy (Kick Gurry) has dreams of grandeur for his band. He fantasizes of the day that his band will make it big and play to sold-out crowds of screaming girls all craving his body. The problem is, the band lives in a Sydney suburb with virtually no way to get discovered, a problem magnified by the manager's ineptitude. Desperate for a gig, a chance encounter brings Freddy and his band a little closer to his dream when he meets the manager of Australia's most popular band.

On the verge of a possible breakout for the band, Freddy must struggle to prevent his band from breaking up due to internal conflict. Infidelity and midnight kisses lead to a battle of bed mates as emotions clash and relationships are broken and created.

Perhaps the most shocking thing about the film is its director. Alexander Proyas has left behind the dark and brooding Gothic style of previous films "The Crow" and "Dark City" to bring to life the most vibrant and colorful film of his career. There are more colors in the first five minutes of "Garage Days" than in both of his previous works combined.

Proyas has shown a real knack for creating memorable images that, once inserted into your mind, do not leave.

"Garage Days" is filled with many similar images, in fact, that with each subsequent viewing, more will be discovered. From a bizarre and wickedly funny drug trip scene featuring
