'Road to the White House' panel to address voting behavior

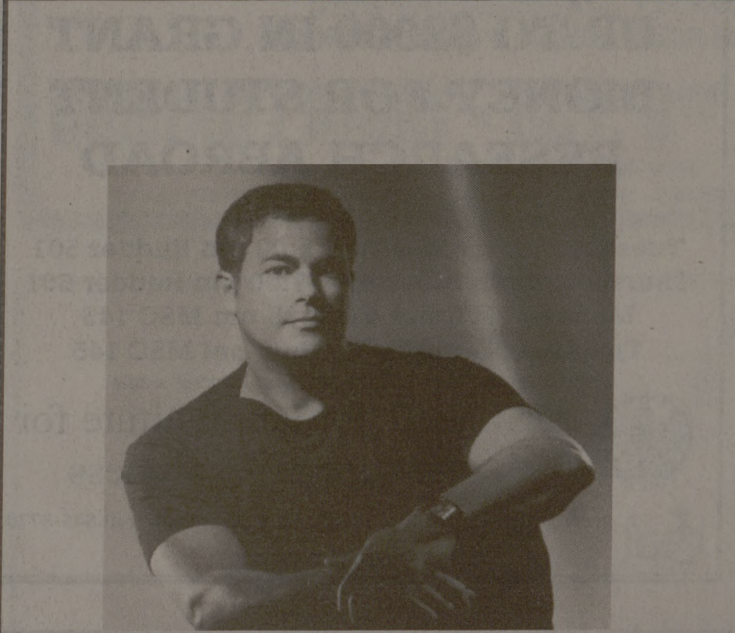
