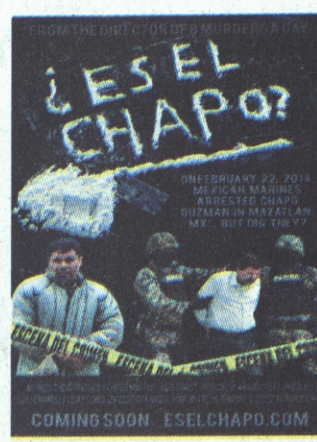

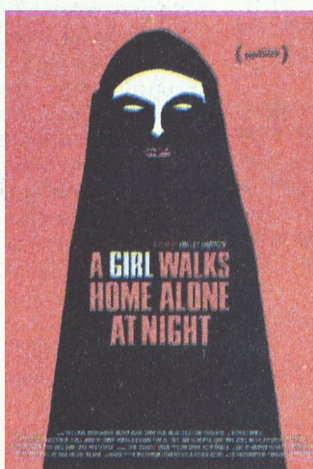
"Es El Chapo?"

"The Hobbit: The Battle of the Five Armies"



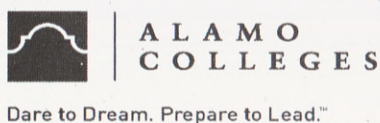

fourth in the nation in batting average at .320 on the year. The Aggie pitching is one of the best in the nation, ranking second in the country in team ERA at 2.08. They have only surrendered 87 runs and have allowed five home runs, both statistics are of which are best in the SEC. Tuesday night, the Aggies will most likely send freshman Turner Larkins to the mound for his ninth start this season. Larkins is 4-1 with a 3.11 ERA on the year, adding 37

strikeouts to the stat sheet. The Owls have a variety of choices, but will most likely send Glenn Otto to the mound. The Aggies are the first team to reach 30 wins this season after beating Kentucky on Saturday. Last year, the Aggies did not win game No. 30 until defeating LSU on May 4. This season, Texas A&M is 9-0 in mid-week contests, outscoring its opponents 73 to 17 in those games. A&M is 22-1 at home this year, while Rice is 7-6 when playing away from home. First pitch is scheduled for 6:30 p.m.
